The information in relation to the processing of personal data by the National Science Centre

for all those participating in the events organised by the National Science Centre

- 1. For the purposes of the events organised by the National Science Centre (hereinafter referred to as the "NCN"), we collect images of the persons concerned that will be recorded on pictures and in films (hereinafter referred to as the: "Personal Data").
- 2. The National Science Centre with its registered office in Krakow at ul. Twardowskiego 16, 30-312 Kraków, is the controller of the Personal Data.
- 3. Should one need any information on his/her Personal Data and/or other rights to the Personal Data processed by the National Science Centre, the NCN's designated Data Protection Officer can be contacted by e-mail at iod@ncn.gov.pl, by phone at +48 12 341 9113 or directly at the registered office of the data controller.
- 4. Personal Data will be processed by the National Science Centre pursuant to Article 6 (1) (a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU L 2016, No 119, p. 1).
- By participating in an event organised by the NCN, participants and observers consent to the dissemination and processing of their images on pictures and in films made during the event along with other Personal Data (if any) collected for the purposes of the event.
- 6. There is no obligation to provide Personal Data, however without their disclosure one cannot participate in the event organised by the NCN.
- 7. Personal Data will be collected by the NCN for the purposes of:
 - a. training, information and marketing events organised by the National Science Centre.
 - b. drafting written, photographic and film reports of the events,
 - c. publishing reports of such events on NCN's website, social media profiles of the National Science Centre, and in other information and marketing materials drafted and published by the National Science Centre and providing reports of such events to journalists and media representatives.
- Personal Data will be stored before, during and after an event for the period and to the
 extent required by generally applicable laws and for the period of storage, as defined
 by the NCN's records management procedures and the Uniform File Classification
 System.
- 9. Your Personal Data (i.e. your image) will be transferred to third countries (outside of the EEA) that, according to the European Commission, ensure an 'adequate' level of personal data protection. In such an event, data will be provided pursuant to generally applicable laws, ensuring adequate protection pursuant to standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission.
- 10. The data subject has the right to be informed on the processing of their Personal Data, correct their Personal Data, restrict the processing of their Personal Data and remove their Personal Data.
- 11. The data subject has the right to remove his/her consent to the processing of his/her Personal Data at any time, without breaching the right to the processing pursuant to the consent before it was revoked;
- 12. The recipients of your Personal Data will include:

- a. entities to which the National Science Centre will transfer the processing of your Personal Data under Article 28 of the Regulation for the purposes of services to be provided by such entities to the National Science Centre, in particular for the purposes of organising training, information and marketing events, whereas the recipients will be bound to keep the data being processed confidential even when their legal relationship with the National Science Centre expires,
- b. individuals using the NCN's website and social media channels run by the NCN,
- c. individuals using publications printed, issued and distributed by the National Science Centre, and
- d. journalists and media representatives.
- 13. Any Personal Data collected may be disclosed to other entities involved in the organisation of events or participating in the events organised by the National Science Centre or entities authorised to collect Personal Data pursuant to generally applicable laws.
- 14. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if he/she finds that the processing is in breach of the General Data Protection Regulation.
