



RESOLUTION NO 48/2026

of 11 June 2026

BY THE COUNCIL OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE

on the international BiodivFuture call: “Novel ecosystems: biodiversity, socio-ecological consequences and future trajectories” launched under the European Biodiversity Partnership: Rescuing Biodiversity to Safeguard Life on Earth

Acting pursuant to Article 20 (1) (4) and Article 20 (1) (7) of the Act on the National Science Centre of 30 April 2010 (consolidated text in Journal of Laws 2026, item 101), and in connection with the Letter from the Minister of Education and Science of 23 September 2021 requesting the National Science Centre to act as the national coordinator of the Partnership “Rescuing Biodiversity to Safeguard Life on Earth” under Horizon Europe, the NCN Council hereby lays down the terms of NCN’s international BiodivFuture call: “Novel ecosystems: biodiversity, socio-ecological consequences and future trajectories”, hereinafter referred to as the “Call”, launched under the Partnership as follows:

- 1) the Call will be carried out pursuant to the Terms and regulations on awarding funding for research tasks funded or co-funded under international calls launched by the National Science Centre and carried out as multilateral collaboration UNISONO, as laid down in NCN Council Resolution No 74/2025 of 11 September 2025,
- 2) the Call is open to funding proposals for basic and applied research projects, as laid down in Article 4 (2) of the Act on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (consolidated text in Journal of Laws 2024, item 1571, as amended), in any academic discipline covered by NCN panels adopted by the NCN Council,
- 3) the Call is subject to the disciplines and groups of disciplines as defined and adopted pursuant to NCN Council Resolution No 27/2025 of 20 March 2025, and
- 4) under the Call, state aid is restricted to basic research only.
